excellent coat and feathering. Very well shown. 3 Miller's Sh Ch Quilesta So Majestic of Rockfest.

VD (5,2) 1 Disney's Sh Ch Wonglepong Will's Faramir. All male, top of standard. Nice head and expression, good coat, good broad hips. Moved well at 7 years old. 2 Lloyd and Smith's Ch Crumpsbrook Bayleaf Von Rulander. Different type to the winner, lighter in build, but a very nice example of the breed. 8 years old. 3 Day's Raycris Constantin at Alfriston.
